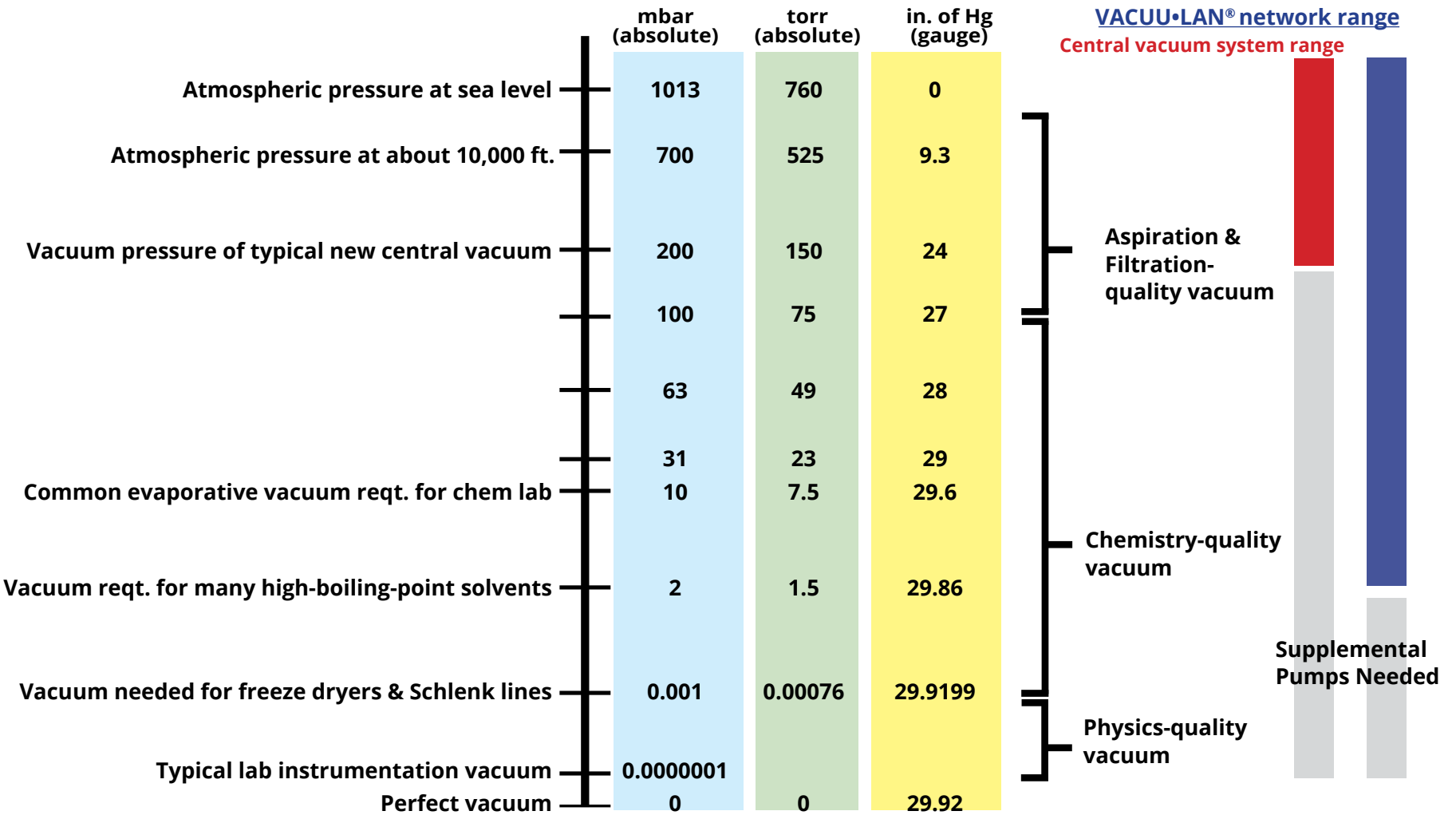




Scales used for vacuum measurement in engineering and construction literature are sometimes presented as gauge pressures, with atmospheric pressure corresponding to zero, and values rising as pressure decreases. This chart compares one such scale to scientific absolute pressure scales.
